Aged for a minimum of 4 years before release, the Brut Reserve is exceptional with citrus and pears leading to notes of hazelnut and finally a touch of buttery brioche.</i>			
<b>14. PALMER &amp; CO ROSÉ SOLERA NV</b>			<b>£60.00</b>
<i>This is an extraordinary wine, the reserve wine is enriched by a 35 year old Solera, to create the wonderfully vibrant colour and beautifully balanced rose wine.</i>			
<b>15. VEUVE CLICQUOT YELLOW LABEL BRUT NV</b>			<b>£85.00</b>

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*Ripe and rounded with plum, bramble fruit and blackcurrant flavours. Medium-bodied with soft tannins and a long, fresh finish.*

<b>26. SOME YOUNG PUNKS 'THE SQUIDS FIST' SANGIOVESE SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA</b>	<b>£5.80</b>	<b>£9.00</b>	<b>£11.60</b>	<b>£26.00</b>
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*Some Young Punks epitomise the best of New Australia. Similar to most amongst the new breed of interesting, young winemakers in Australia they have moved away from the Porty Shiraz to make wines with a sense of place and restraint, influenced by the best of the Old World and the New. The full, rich fruit of McLaren Vale Shiraz is cleverly partnered with the Borossa-sourced savoury Sangiovese to create a dangerously gluggable wine.*

<b>27. VISTA FLORES MALBEC CATENA APPELLATION, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA</b>				<b>£45.00</b>
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*Catena are famed for their pioneering role in high-altitude viticulture, the Vista Flores is the perfect example with fruit sourced from vineyards over 1000 metres above sea level. This altitude creates wines with a real purity, concentration and elegance.*

<b>29. GEVREY CHAMBERTIN DOMAINE ROUX, BURGUNDY, FRANCE</b>				<b>£85.00</b>
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*Domaine Roux Pere et Fils winemaking heritage stretches back to 1855 and they now own over 70 hectares of vineyards across the region. This Gevrey Chambertin is fine and stylish with well-judged oak and a defined, long finish.*

## SHERRY

<b>30. LA GUITA, MANZANILLA (HALF BOTTLE), SPAIN</b>				<b>£15.00</b>
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*The name 'La Guita' comes from the old Andalucian slang guita meaning cash (due to its founder being renowned for wanting to be paid in cash). Made in Sanlúcar de Barrameda, La Guita is dry and tangy with subtle nutty flavours.*
