

Patara Elephant Farm

Experience on participating, sharing responsibilities and taking care of an elephant. "Elephant Owner for a Day" is a special program created for everyone to learn and interact with elephants as what an owner would do daily, during which time you are trained to approach your elephant correctly, know the elephant's temperament, feed and check its health, learn about and take care of your own elephant, bathe and brush it in the river, learn how to ride on its neck, and communicate through different spoken commands. You will get a chance to bare-back riding to visit forests, waterfalls or local temples. The program is specialized and meaningful activity to create trust and relationship between you and your elephant.



Chiang Mai Night Safari

Doi Suthep Temple

Wat Phra That Doi Suthep is the most important temple in Chiang Mai, Thailand. Built in the early 19th Buddhist century, the beauty of Wat Phra That Doi Suthep is marked by seven-headed serpent statues that line the stairs to the temple where a Chiang Saen style golden pagoda and all its exquisite Lanna architecture is situated.

Chiang Rai Golden Triangle

One of the most worthy trip you must try while staying at Karma Royal Belle Vista is one day trip to Chiang Rai Golden Triangle. Wat Rong Khun, perhaps better known to foreigners as the White Temple, is a contemporary, unconventional, privately-owned art exhibit in the style of a Buddhist temple in Chiang Rai Province, Thailand. Moreover, a visit to nature hot spring, Longneck tribal Village, sitting on slow boat acrossing Mae Kong River to Laos border and shopping at Mae Sai Burma Border is highly recommended.

Grand Canyon

Chiang Mai Grand Canyon is a waterpark built in an abandoned limestone quarry. The quarry has been empty for many years and was naturally filled with water by monsoon rains. It became a popular swimming spot because of the natural beauty of the canyon. The water is bright blue and the canyon walls are very steep and, in the past you could jump from the top of the cliffs into the water. In August 2016, the Chiang Mai Grand Canyon waterpark was opened. It offers an inflatable obstacle course, slides, a small zipline and wakeboarding.

Chiang Mai Night Bazaar


A good way to check out the whole thing is to start at Tha Phae Road and work your way south towards Loi Khro. Once you reach the end of the market, cross the street and work your way back along the other side. Don't forget to peek down the little sois (alleyways) and arcades along the way. If you see something you like you might want to be patient-there are hundreds of vendors and an absolute flood of products for sale.

Chiang Mai Three King Monuments

The Chiang Mai Three Kings monument, known as the “Anusawari Sam Kasat”, is found in the center of the majestic ancient walled city of Chiang Mai. The visually impacting Three Kings Monument was erected in front of the Chiang Mai City art and Cultural Center, the purpose of the latter monument is meant to immortalize the 3 kings that founded Chiang Mai in 1296.
