

Coming from Dabolim (Goa International Airport):

Goa is connected by air, road and rail. The drive from the Goa International airport is 22.6kms down South which passes the scenic landscape through the quaint and peaceful villages of Majorda and Colva to get to our slice of Goan Paradise, Benaulim.

The nearest Bus stand and railway station are both in our cultural and commercial capital Margao which is also known as Madgaon. Bus terminal is 6.4 kms and railway station is 5.8 kms by car.

Services of Taxi's can be availed from the prepaid counter at the airport or railway station and tuk-tuk's (auto-rickshaw) are available at the Margao railway station as well as at Margao bus terminal. The resort, if informed in advance can also organize an airport pick-up at an extra charge.

There are also local buses available for commuting from the resort to Margao and vice versa. The bus stop for the local buses is 1 kms away from the resort.

Mangeshi Temple

Mangeshi Temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is considered to be the most important temple in Goa located in Mangeshi Village in Ponda- Goa which is at a distance of 31.4 kms from our resort. This temple was built in year 1560 and is considered to be one of the largest and most frequently visited temple in Goa.

Shantadurga Temple

This temple is dedicated to Goddess Shantadurga "the Goddess of Peace". The temple is a combination of Indo-Portuguese architecture located in DonshiwadoPonda which is around 23.8 kms from our resort.

Basilica of Bom Jesus

Basilica Of Bom Jesus is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The basilica holds the mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier. The church is located in Old Goa which is around 33.2 kms from our resort, which was the capital of Goa in the early days of Portuguese rules.











Fort Aguada & Sinquerim Beach

Fort Aguada and its lighthouse is a well-preserved seventeenth-century Portuguese fort standing in Goa, India, on Sinquerim Beach, overlooking the ArabianSea.

Baga & Calangute Beach

One of the most popular beaches of Goa, Baga Beach is located close to Calangute beach. It is named after the 'Baga creek' which flows into the Arabian Sea and isthe perfect destination to witness beautiful sunsets and enjoy the cool morning breeze.

Calangute is termed as the Queen of Beaches, Calangute is the first choice for every tourist that lands on the soil of Goa. The Calangute beach has stretched its boundaries in the northeast of the capital city of Panaji.

Palolem & Agonda Beach

Palolem beach is one of the beautiful beaches in all of Goa. A natural bay surrounded by lofty headlands on either side.

The Agonda beach is an isolated place that makes this place more beautiful, silent, quiet, and peaceful beach. If you are lucky you can spot a turtle lay eggs on the beach and it is just amazing experience. Try boat ride for dolphin watching and visiting other islands nearby.

Cabo de Rama Fort

Cabo de Rama is an old & abandoned Portuguese era fort build on the hilly region & seashore of Arabian sea in South Goa. This is under the stewardship of Archaeological dept. of India. This place has an excellent view of sea.

Bogmolo Beach & Naval Museum

Bogmalo Beach is a small beach-side village in Goa, India. It is situated in a small bay with around a mile of curving sandy beach.

Menezes Braganza House - Chandor

The Menezes Braganza Pereira house is located at the Chandor village in Goa. It is known to be more than 350 years old and is situated near the church square in Chandor.

Palacio de Deao-Quepem

This 213 years old mansion was built by a Portuguese noble man, who was the Dean of the Church, and founder of Quepem town. The house faces the Church he built and is on the banks of the wildly beautiful Kushavati River. It is built in an unusual style blending elements of Hindu and Portuguese architecture.

Panjim City

Panaji, also known as Panjim, is the state capital of Goa, in southwest India. Located on the banks of the Mandovi River which is at a distance of 36 kms from our resort, the city has cobblestone streets lined with colourful villas and buildings from the Portuguese colonial era. Palm-fringed Miramar Beach sits at the confluence of the river and the Arabian Sea. Set on a hill overlooking the city is the baroque Our Lady of Immaculate Conception Church, built in 1619.

Dona Paula Jetty

Dona Paula Jetty - located on the beautiful and famous sea stretch that spans from Panjim, Miramar and Dona Paula which is at a distance of 36.6 kms from our resort. It provides a magnificent view of the Mormugao harbour. Dona Paula Jetty is nestled on a rocky, hammer shaped headland.











Miramar Beach

Miramar is the beach area of the Goan capital of Panjim, also known as Panaji and is one of the most visited beaches of Goa which is at a distance of 38.7 kms from our resort.

Anjuna Flea Market

Anjuna's weekly Wednesday flea market is as much part of the Goan experience as a day on the beach. You get sculptures and jewellery courtesy of the Tibetan and Kashmiri traders; colourful Gujarati tribal women selling T-shirts; richly colourful saris, bags and bedspreads from Rajasthan; sacks of spices from Kerala; The best time to visit is early (from 8am) or late afternoon (around 4pm till close just after sunset). The first market of the season is around mid-November, continuing till the end of April.


Arpora Night Market

The Saturday Night Market is located at Arpora in North Goa also called Ingo's Night Market, it is open between 4 PM and 11 PM from November to April. The night market attracts a huge number of tourists – both Europeans and Indians. It is particularly popular with foreign tourists, and the hippie culture. You will find many stalls run by Europeans, making the ambience distinctively cosmopolitan.











Froggyland Water Park

Froggyland the Water World was established in the year 2015. An amusement park, which offers thrilling and excitement rides of international standards. Daily Open from 10.00pm to 6.00pm (Monday closed)

Go Karting

If you are game for adventure and love driving in the fast lane then you must visit the Go Karting track located in Nuvem village, in Salcette South Goa. This track is considered as one of the best Go Karting tracks in India. Open from 4.00pm to 10.00pm (Monday closed)

Goa Chitra Museum

The Goa Chitra is a museum based in the former Portuguese colony of Goa. It has a large collectionover 4000 artefacts-focusing on Goa's traditional agrarian technology and lifestyle. Goa Chitra is based in the coastal Goan village of Benaulim. Daily open from 9.00am to 6.00pm

Big Foot Goa Museum

A miniature Goan village set up to recreate the rural life of old days. It is privately run by an artist called Maendra Jocelino Araujo Alvares. The open-air museum recreates Goan rural life as it was a hundred years ago. Daily open from 9.00am to 6.00pm.

Wax World Museum

Old Goa is the home to India's second wax museum. The museum has over 30 life-size, statues of famous personalities of Indian culture, heritage and religion. One of the main attractions is the sculpting of the 'last supper' which is 22 feet in length and weights 500 kilos. Open daily from 9.30am to 6.30pm

Snow Park


Indoor park with a sledding hill & ice bar, plus areas for kids & adults to play in manmade snow. Snow Park has created a design for a unique snow play centre to entertain the whole family 365 days a year. The aim is to introduce unlimited snow fun to whole family, especially in places where snow is an exotic experience. One can enjoy slides on ice and also a sledging car. There are snow play areas for kids and adults where they can build a snow man, igloos or snow balling areas where they can start a snow ball fight with friends. Snow caves and igloos can be created for snow edutainment. Open daily from 10.30am to 7.00pm



Dudhsagar Waterfalls

The majestic cascade of white water, gushing over the steep, nearly vertical face of the mountain from a spectacular height of 1017ft; is both breath taking and awe inspiring, making one aware that there are many forces in nature much more powerful that the human mind and body.

The name 'Dudhsagar' literally translates to 'sea of milk' which many believe is an allusion to the white spray and foam that the great waterfall creates as it cascades into the waters of the lake. The falls are at their zenith during the monsoon season, although they are a popular attraction all year round.
